U.S. Department of Labor (DOL), Office of Disability Policy (ODEP) RETAIN Initiative

Bizzell provided general coordination and facilitation for the DOL, ODEP, Retaining Employment and Talent After Injury or Illness Network (RETAIN) awardees in cooperation with the Social Security Administration (SSA) and the SSA-funded independent evaluator. We provided technical support for the stay-at-work/return-to-work (SAW/RTW) early intervention strategies for injured or ill workers. Our assistance validated and brought to scale evidence-based strategies that increased employment retention and labor force participation from individuals who acquired and/or were at risk of developing work disabilities; and, reduced long-term work disability among project participants, including the need for federal disability benefits (i.e., SSDI and SSI).

DOL, Office of Job Corps Center (JCC) Guthrie, Long Beach, New Haven and Tulsa

Bizzell partners with the DOL Employment and Training Administration (ETA) to offer a comprehensive array of support services, resources and programs to JCC Guthrie, Long Beach, New Haven and Tulsa. We oversee operations of facilities with a total of more than 100 acres in California, Connecticut and Oklahoma. Our services include the management of nearly 500 personnel and the provision of educational services to over 1200 students. The educational curriculum encompasses diverse trades — such as automobile maintenance, building and apartment maintenance, building construction, building construction technology, carpentry, cement masonry, certified medical assistant, certified nursing assistant, computer technician A+, culinary arts, electrical, light repair, medical administrative assistant, office administration, painting and glazing, pharmacy technician, plumbing, security and protective services, and welding — and culminates in the attainment of industry-recognized certifications.

National Office of Job Corps (NOJC) Pre-Enrollment and On-Center Student Support (PEO-CSS)

Bizzell, under contract with the DOL's National Office of Job Corps (NOJC), works to improve student outcomes from the very beginning. Pre-enrollment
