DEPARTMENT OF LABOR (DOL) OFFICE OF DISABILITY POLICY (ODEP) RETAIN Initiative

Bizzell provides general coordination and facilitation for the DOL, ODEP, Retaining Employment and Talent After Injury or Illness Network (RETAIN) awardees in cooperation with the Social Security Administration (SSA) and the SSA-funded independent evaluator. Bizzell provides technical assistance in support of the stay-at-work/return-to-work (SAW/RTW) early intervention strategies for injured or ill workers. Bizzell helps validate and bring to scale evidence-based strategies to increase employment retention and labor force participation of individuals who acquire and/or are at risk of developing work disabilities; and, reduce long-term work disability among project participants, including the need for federal disability benefits (i.e., SSDI and SSI).

DEPARTMENT OF LABOR (DOL) OFFICE OF JOB CORPS Guthrie, Long Beach, New Heaven, and Tulsa Job Corps Centers

Bizzell diligently collaborates and supports the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) Employment and Training Administration (ETA), offering a comprehensive array of support services, resources, and programs to the Guthrie, Long Beach, New Haven, and Tulsa Job Corps Centers. Bizzell assumes responsibility for the oversight of operations spanning over 100 acres in California, Connecticut, and Oklahoma. This entails the management of nearly 500 personnel and the provision of educational services to over 1200 students. The educational curriculum encompasses diverse fields, including Culinary Arts, Certified Nursing Assistant, Certified Medical Assistant, Medical Administrative Assistant, Pharmacy Technician, Computer Technician A+, Office Administration, Security and Protective Services, Building and Apartment Maintenance, Electrical, Welding, Carpentry, Plumbing, Building Construction Technology, Building Construction, Cement Masonry, Automobile Maintenance, Light Repair, Painting, and Glazing, resulting in the attainment of industry-recognized certifications.

OFFICE OF JOB CORPS Pre-Enrollment & On-Center Student Support (PEO-CSS)

Under a contract with the Department of Labor's National Office of Job Corps (NOJC), to provide the pre-enrollment and on-center student support, Bizzell develops strategies and approaches to improve student outcomes beginning in the pre-enrollment phase and continuing throughout the students' enrollment. Bizzell assists Job Corps Centers in delivering the effective implementation and management of new tools and resources to address three distinct, but inter-related work areas that focus on student services.

Pre-enrollment

Bizzell increases the capacity of the Outreach and Admissions Offices by using web-based academic and career exploration assessment tools. Our goal is to ensure that more students completed their training programs and understand steps and opportunities to advance within their chosen career sector.

Tools for Aspirant Learners

Bizzell increases the accessibility of web-based academic tools that would serve to support the learning of aspirant students who have typically struggled with literacy and numeracy skills. Bizzell identifies, researches, tests and procures the academic tools to support learning achievement. With a deep understanding of the Center goals, Bizzell selects tools that are adaptive to each learner so that Job Corps' instructors are better able to provide on-going individualized instruction and can readily identify areas in which a student may need additional assistance.

Structured Evening Studies

Bizzell staff reach, teach and engage students outside of their regularly scheduled training day to build and reinforce academic, career and employability skills, and provide opportunities for students to practice or pursue areas of interest that support personal and career success.
